Official Rules

Getting into the game: The Milwaukee Bucks Reading Challenge is open to all Wisconsin children in grades one through eight.

Game Starts: The Reading Challenge begins on January 7th, 2018. Be sure to visit your local library periodically during the 4-week reading challenge and to fill your minutes sheet.

Scoring points: You score a point for every minute you read from a book, magazine, or newspaper.

The Challenge All-Star Level: Score 200 points to become an All-star reader, All-Star Readers are eligible for a complimentary ticket offer to a select Bucks home game! This complimentary ticket is valid only with the purchase of at least one Adult ticket.

The Challenge Hall of Fame Level: For students looking for an extended challenge, complete the 400 minutes work sheet and with the 200 point incentives you will also be entered in to a contest where we will randomly select 5 readers to receive a Bucks fan prize pack!

Reporting Your Score: Record the minutes from books, magazines, and newspapers you read on the scoring sheet you're provided upon registering. Report your scoring sheet to your librarian once it is complete for your complimentary ticket voucher.

Game Ends: The deadline for reporting your final score is Monday February 4th, 2018.

Getting Tickets: Tickets can be ordered online via the website provided on your voucher once the challenge is complete. There will be a place on the online form for your family members and friends to purchase additional tickets at preferred pricing. If you are looking to sit with other families or have a group of 10 or more, please contact our ticket staff below.

Delivery: All tickets will be delivered digitally. You will be able to manage your tickets at bucks.com/accountmanager or via the Bucks app.

Use your mobile device for entry into Fiserv Forum. You are encouraged to transfer seats to each attendee in your group prior to the game
