

# Origami House Plant

Follow each step to complete your plant.  
(If the pot is not something you want to try to make, using your unique color, follow the direction for dirt and tape in place.)



## Materials

Supplies included to make one (1) plant:

- 8) 7.5 x 7.5 cm green paper
- 1) 15 x 15cm brown paper
- 1) 10 x 10 cm unique paper

NOT included in your kit:

- Scissors
- X\_ACTO knife

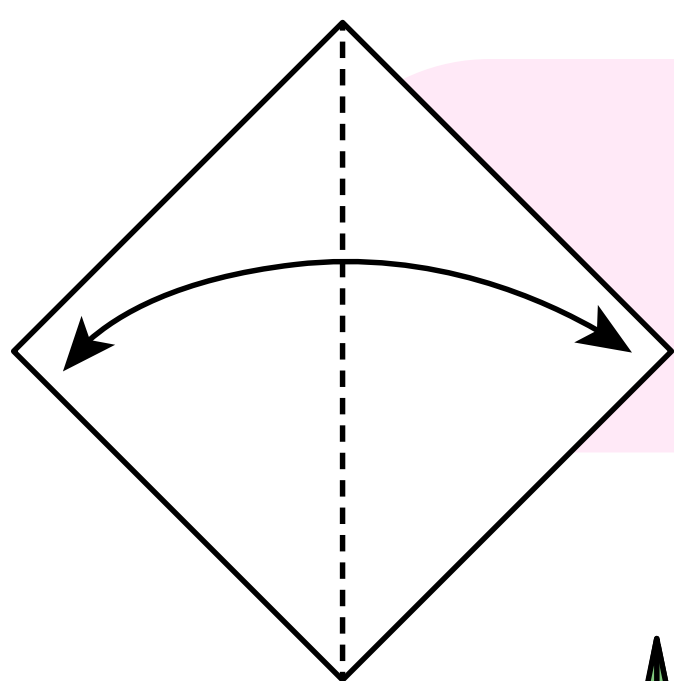


## Succulent:

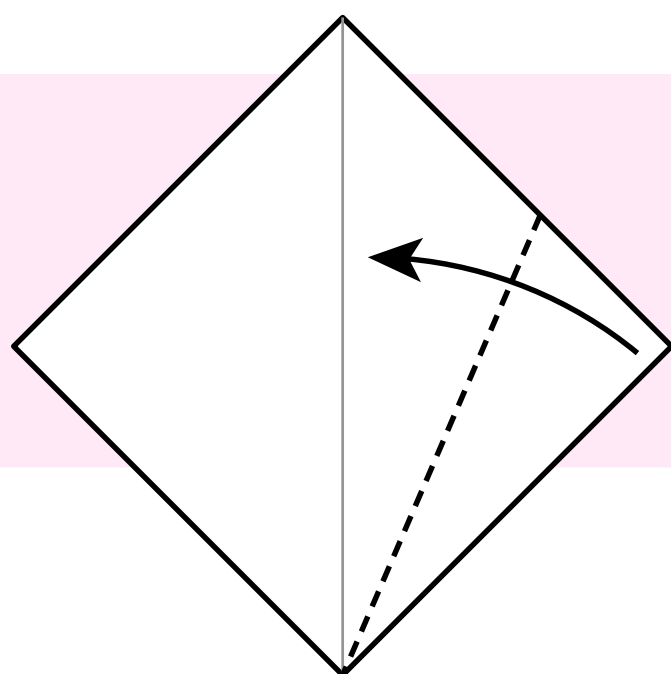
For this step you will need:

8 sheets of 7.5 x 7.5 cm green paper.

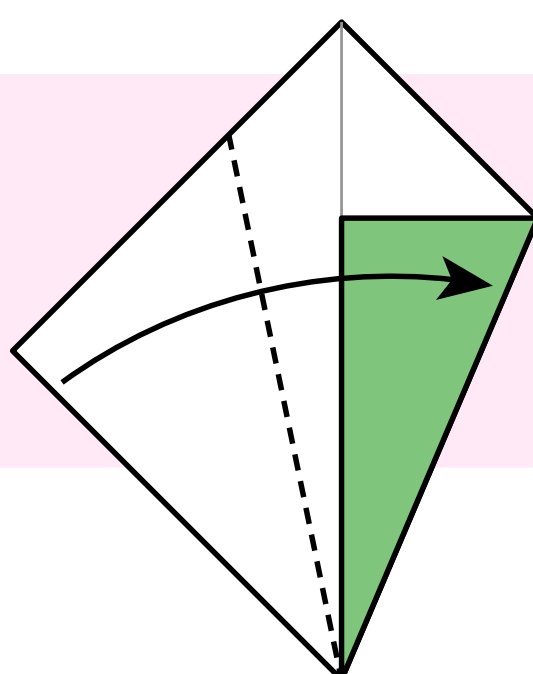
Fold in half.



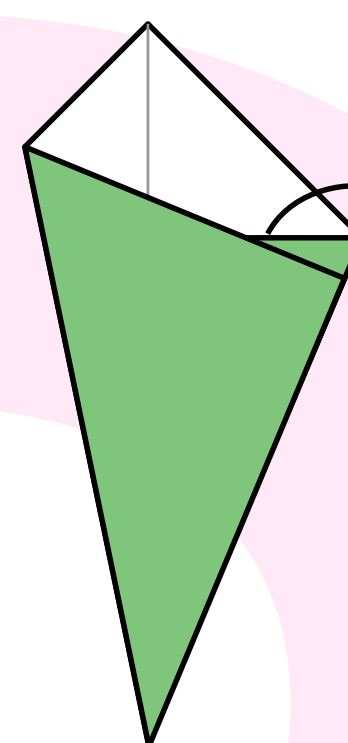
Fold the right half in half.



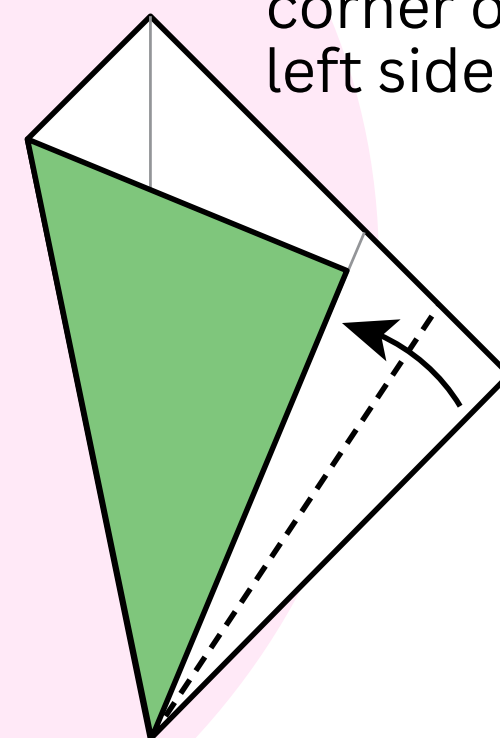
Fold the left half over the right half, all the way to the corner.



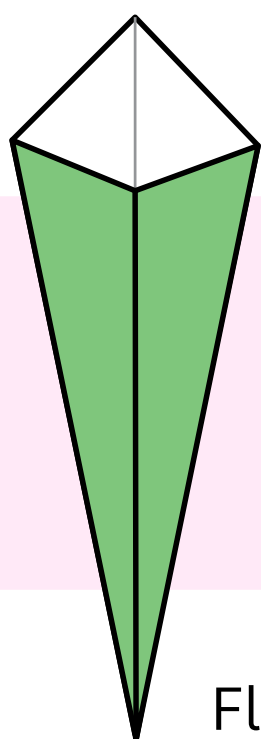
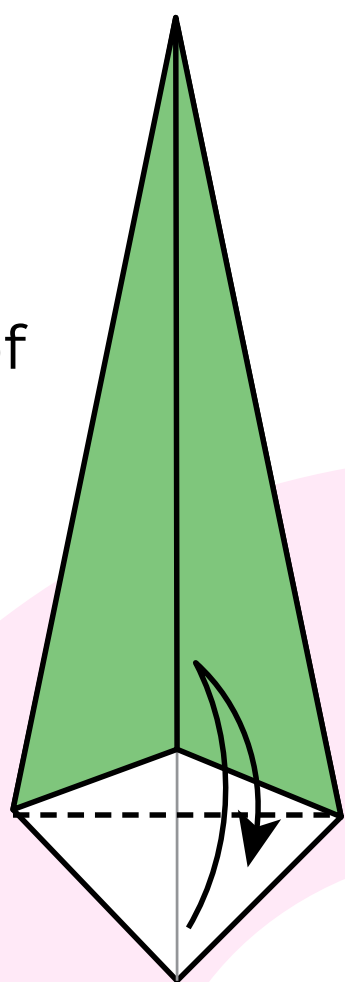
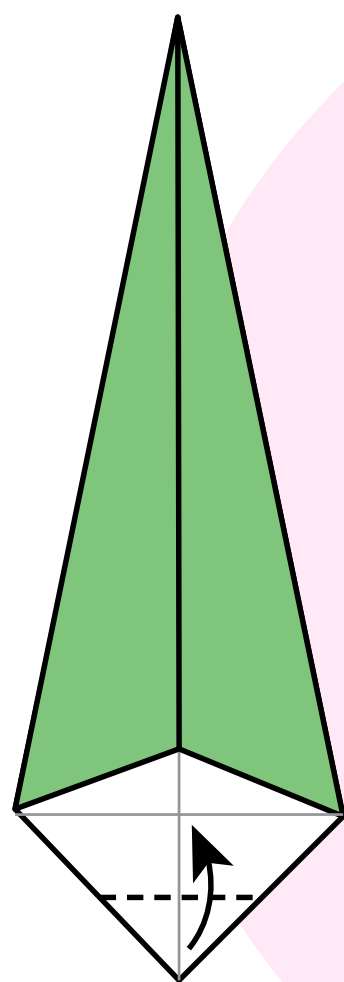
Unfold the right half without moving the left.



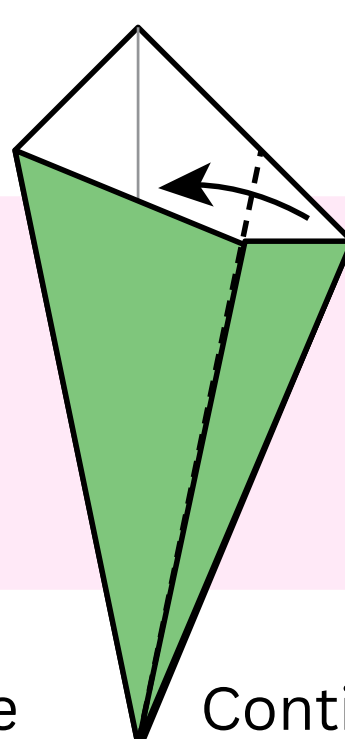
Fold the right corner just until you reach the corner of the left side fold.



Fold the tip of the paper down.

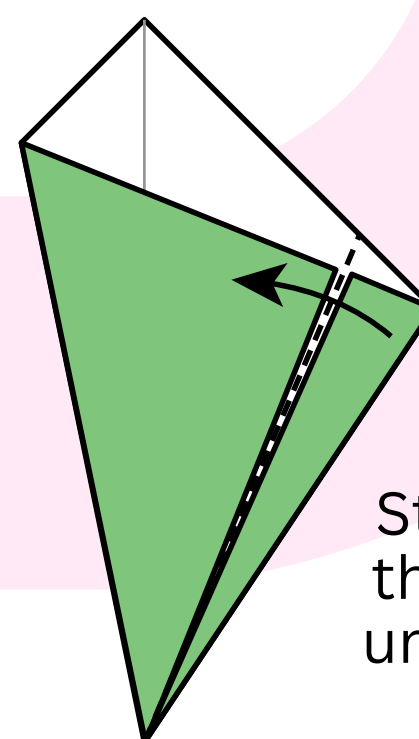


Flip upside down

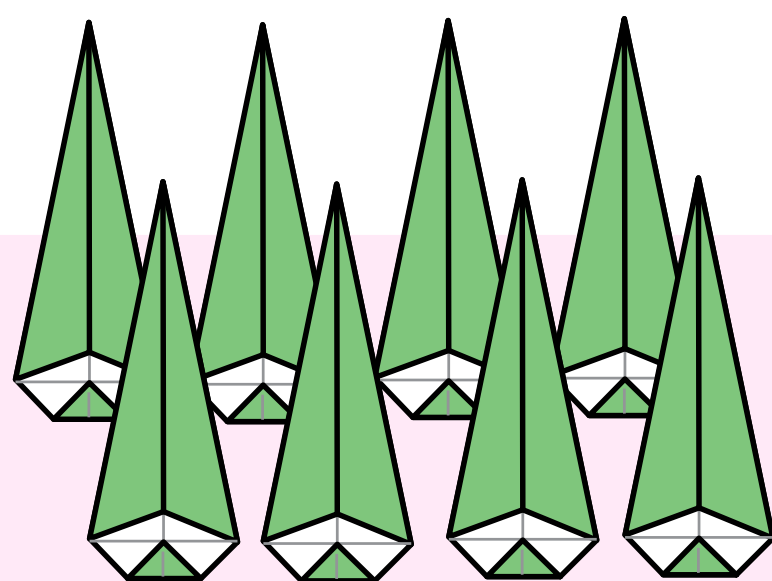
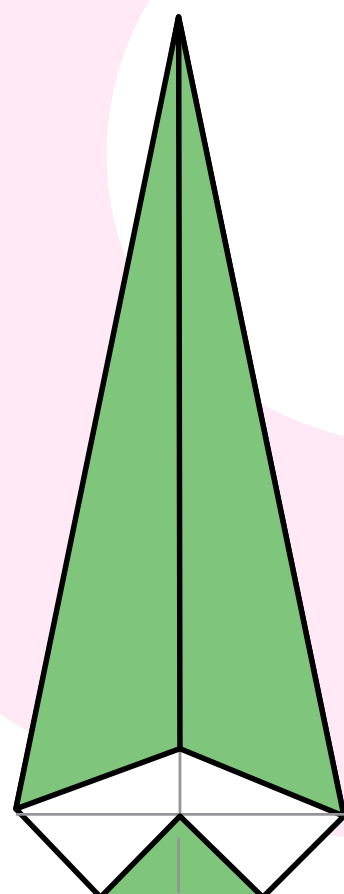


Continue tucking.

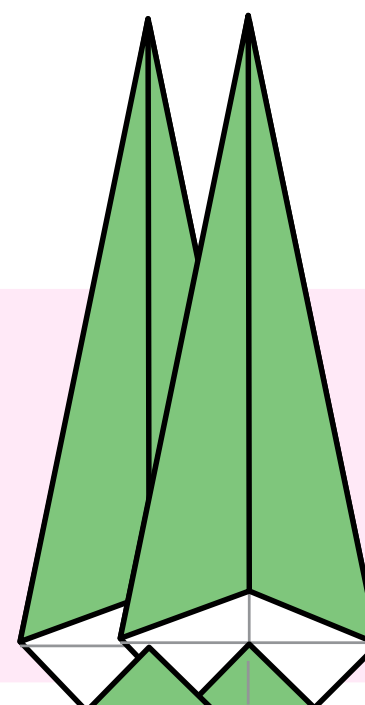
Start tucking the right fold under the left fold.



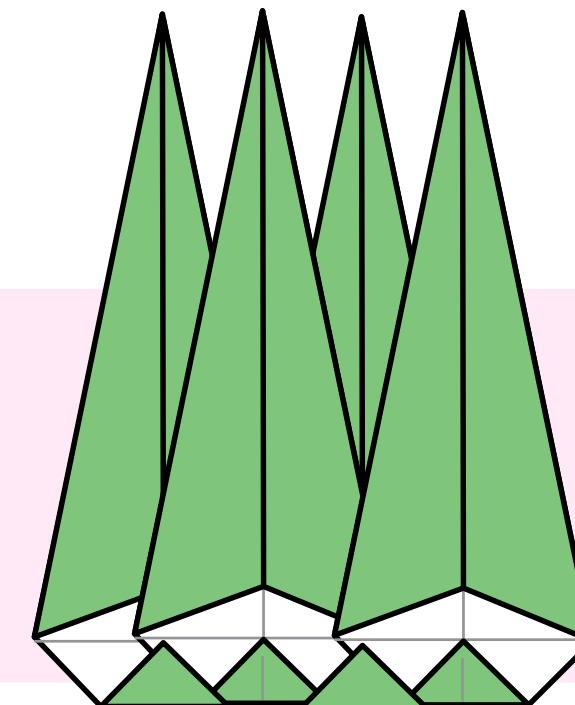
Unfold, and fold the tip in half.



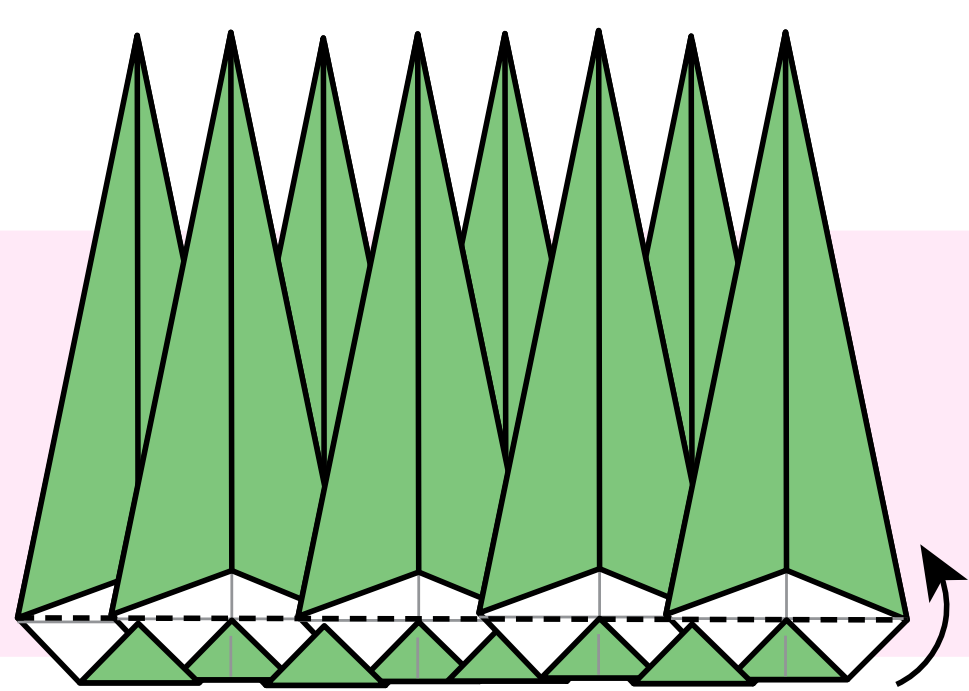
Repeat the above steps 7 more times.



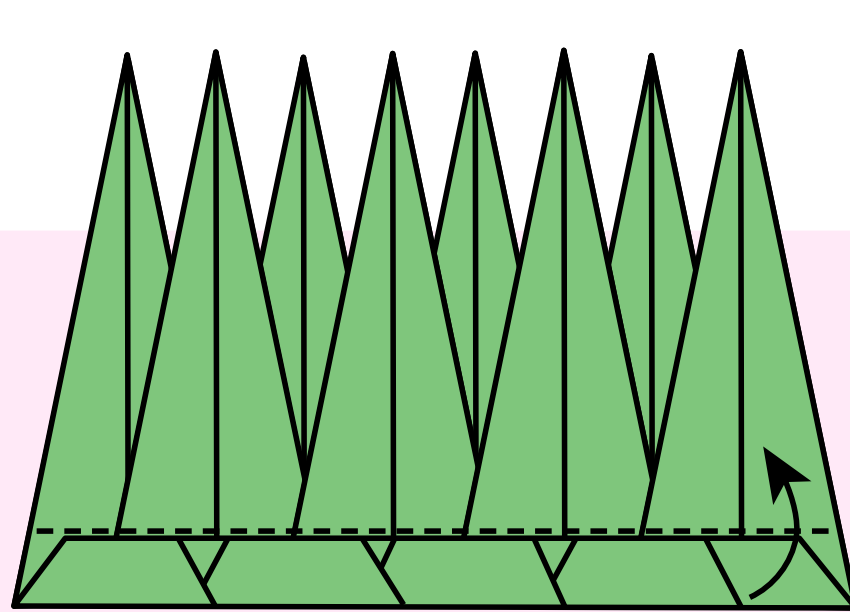
Tuck one leaf into the fold of the next leaf.



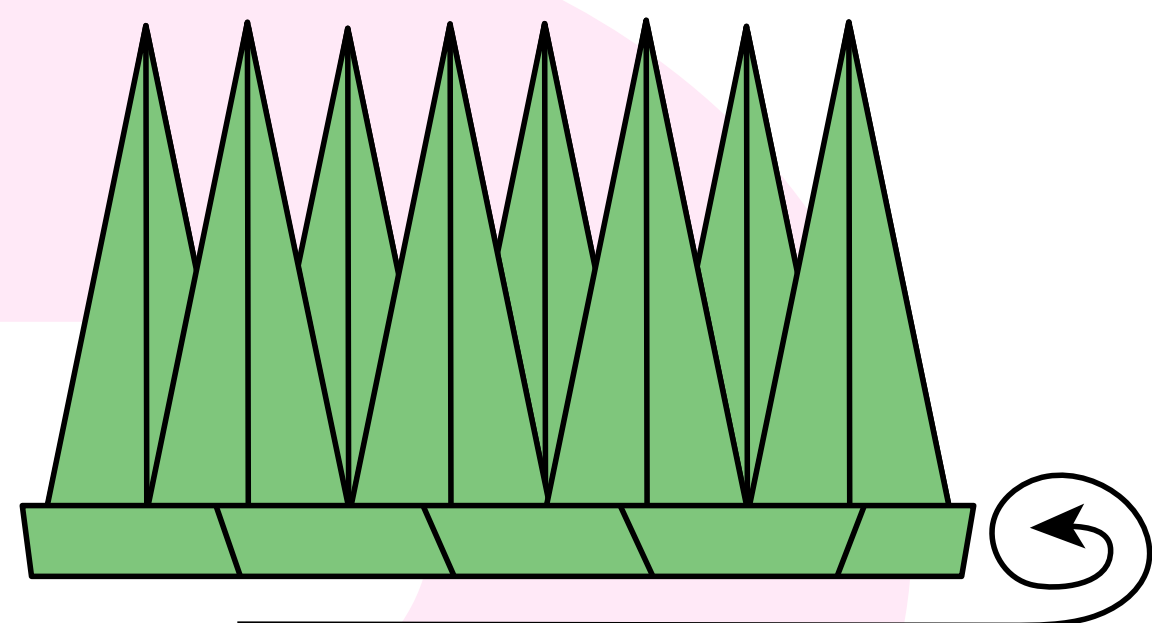
Repeat until all leaves are tucked together.



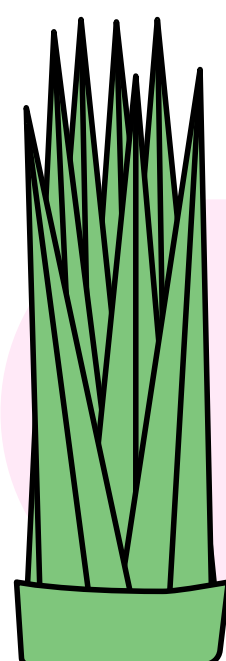
Fold the bottom of the leaves upwards (to this line.)



Fold upwards again to this line.



Roll up the leaves tightly, you can hold them in place with a rubber band until you're ready to use them.



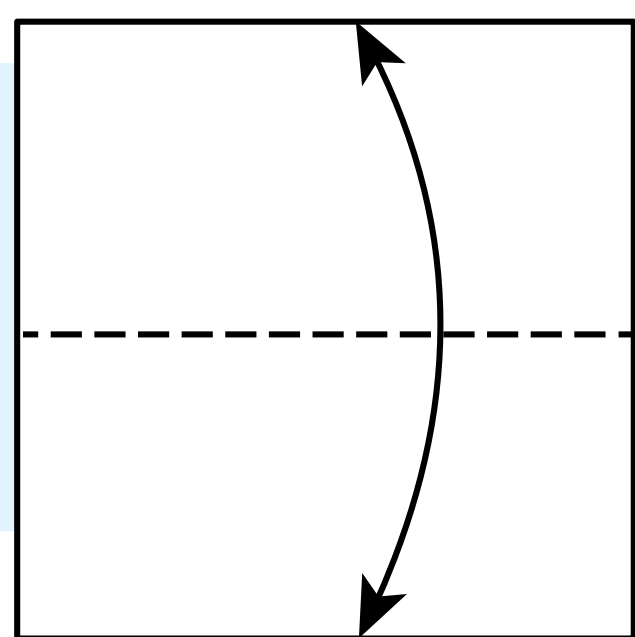
## Pot:

For this step you will need:

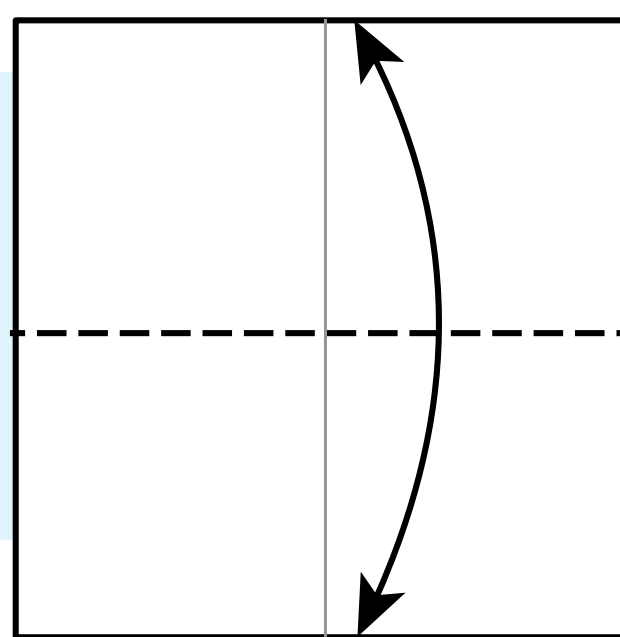
1 sheet of 15 x 15cm paper.

\*See last page of instructions for an alternative to the pot!

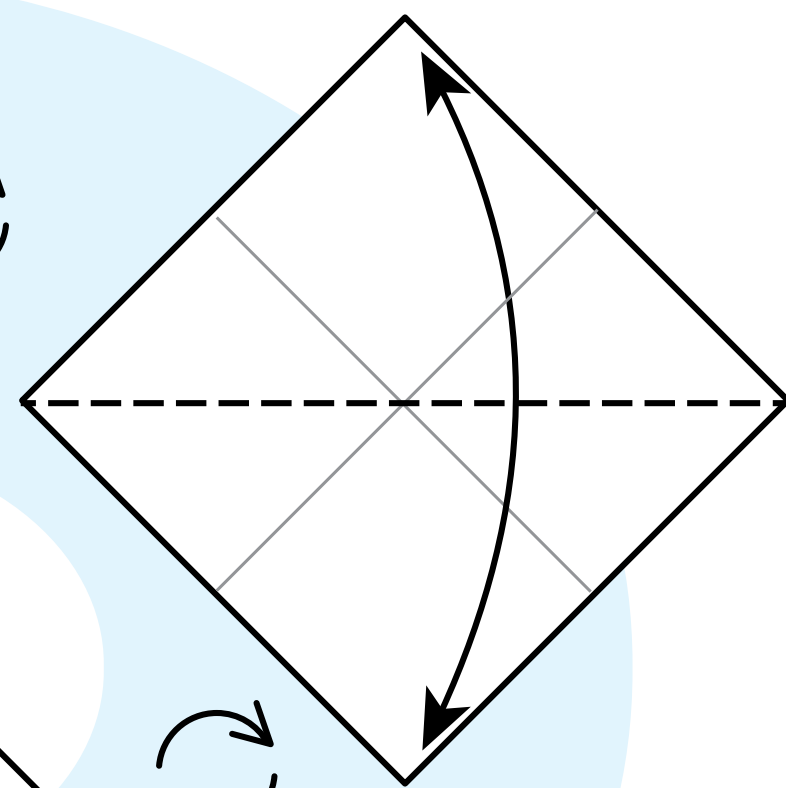
Fold the paper in half.



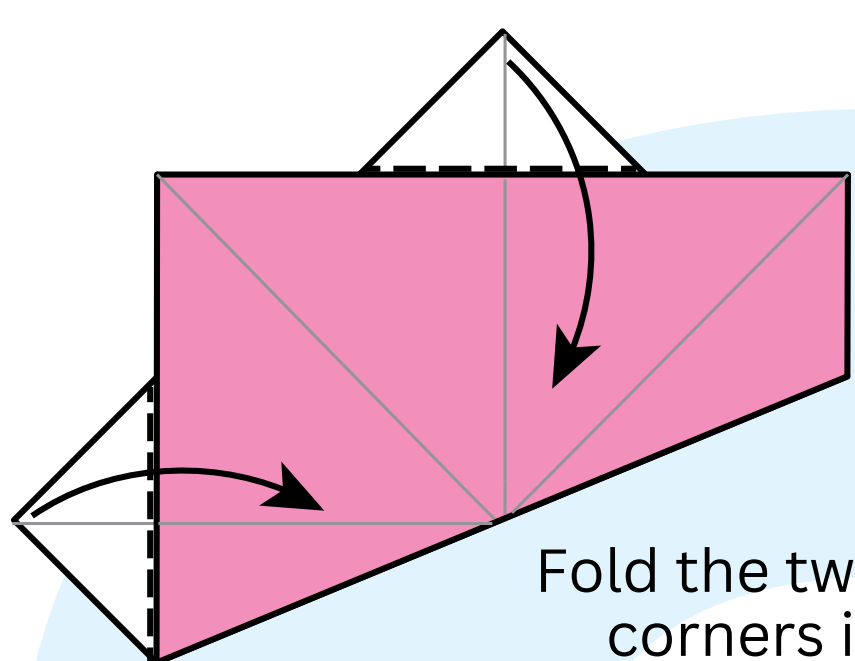
Flip, and fold the paper in half.



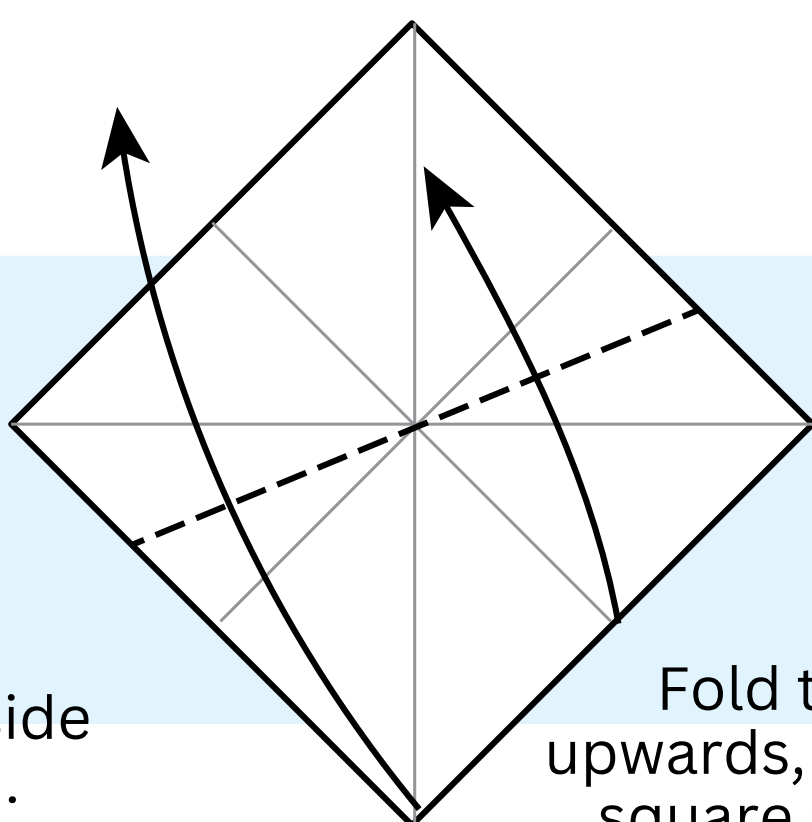
Flip and fold the paper's corner in half.



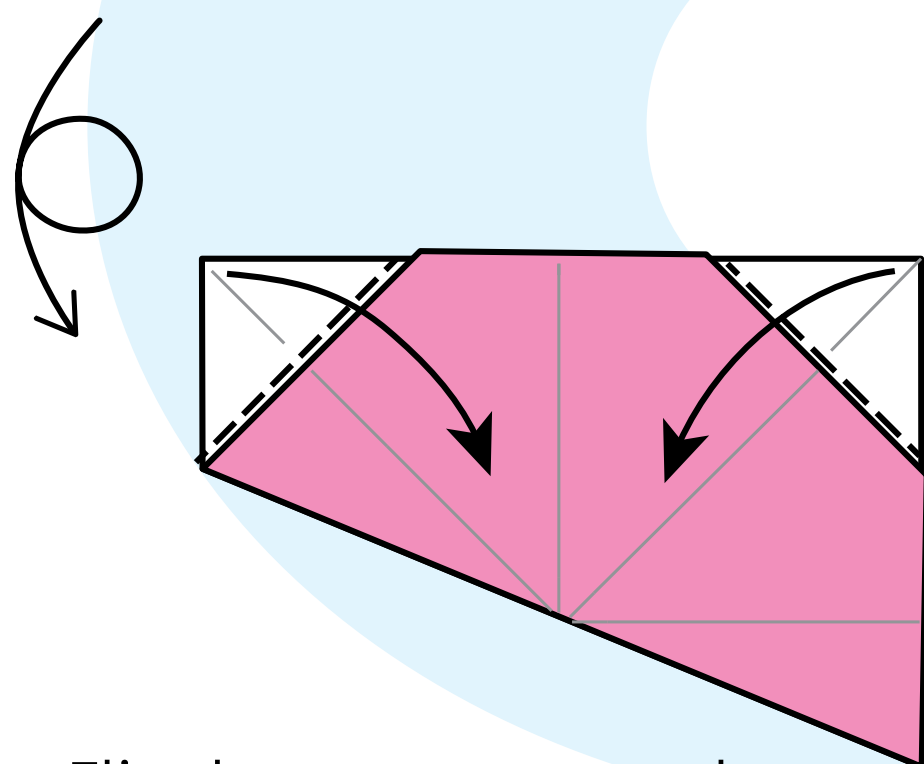
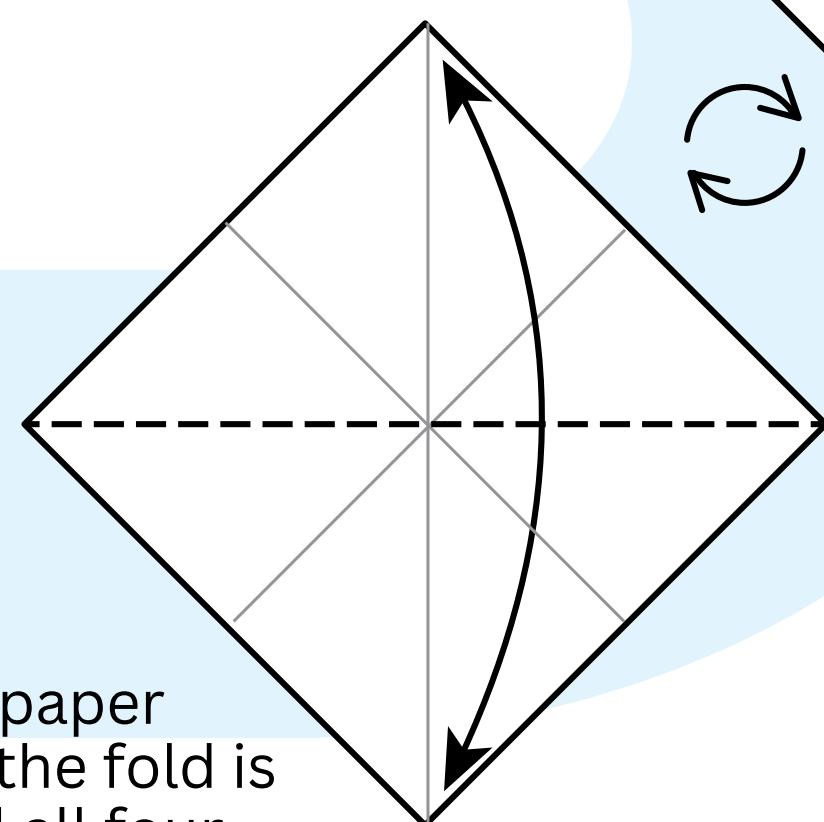
Flip and fold the same way on the other corner.



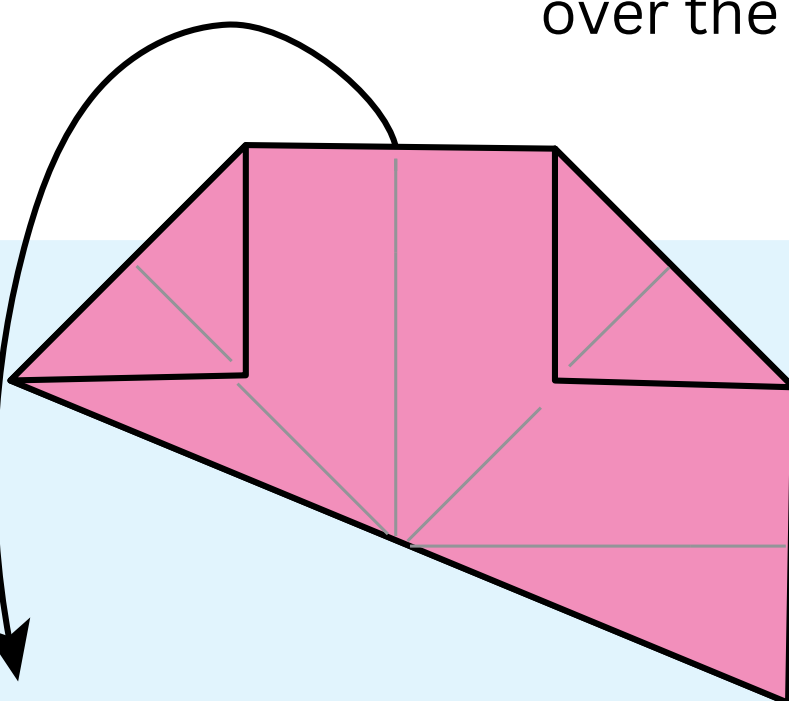
Fold the two outside corners inward.



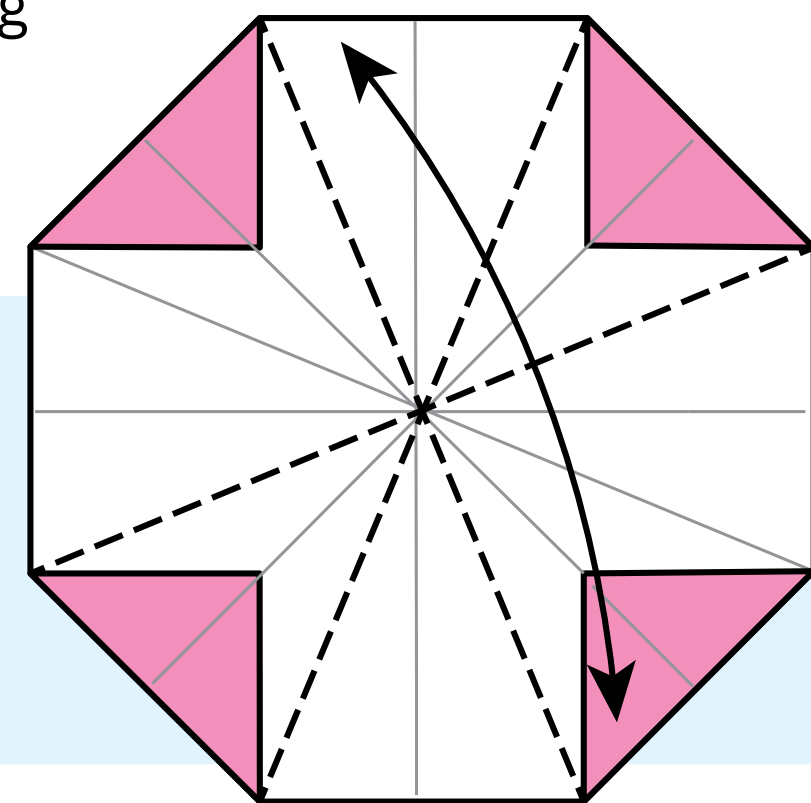
Fold the paper upwards, so the fold is square and all four corners are hanging over the edge.



Flip the paper over and fold the corners inward.

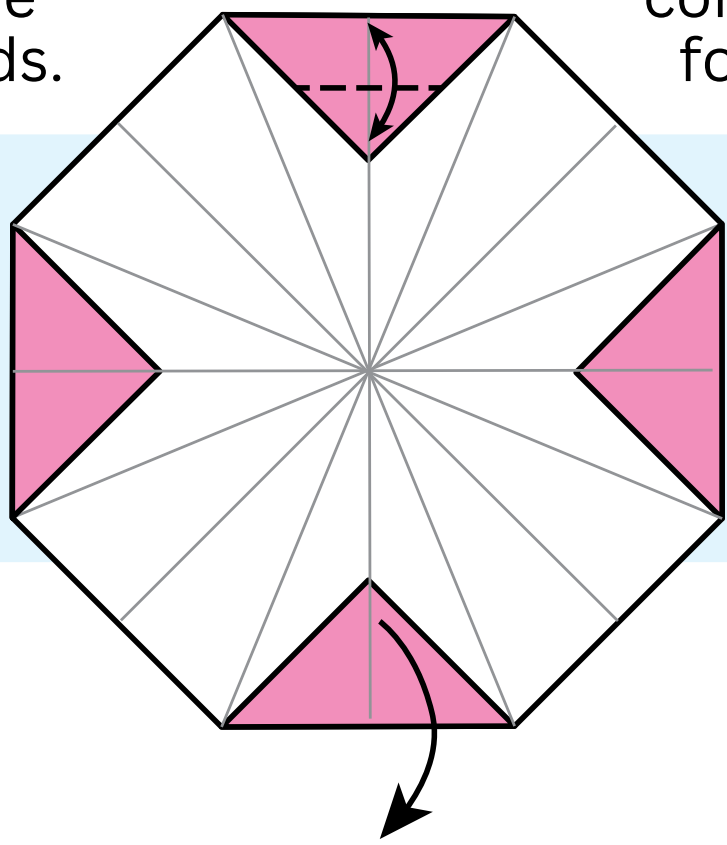


Unfold the paper, but ensure the corners are still folded.

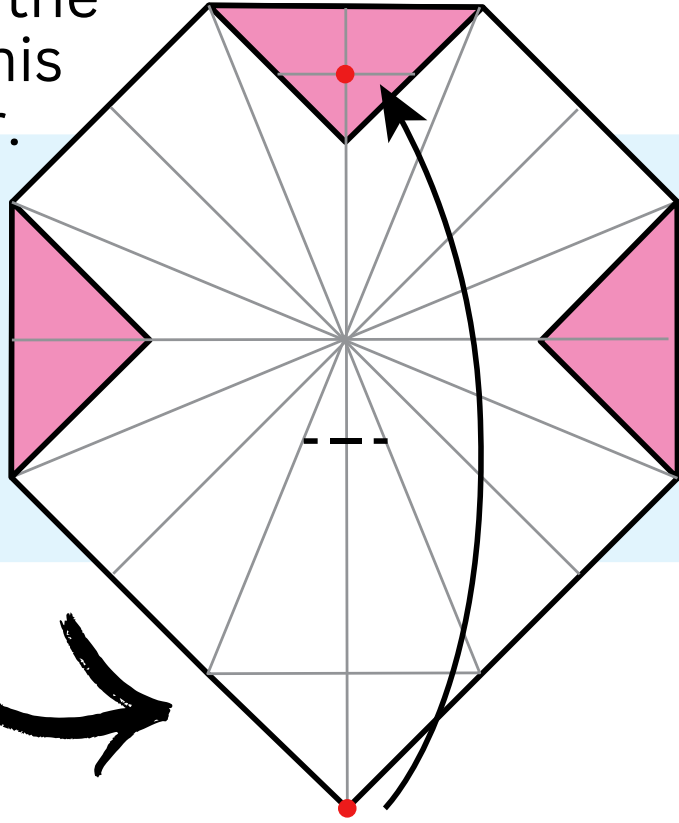


Make creases along these lines.

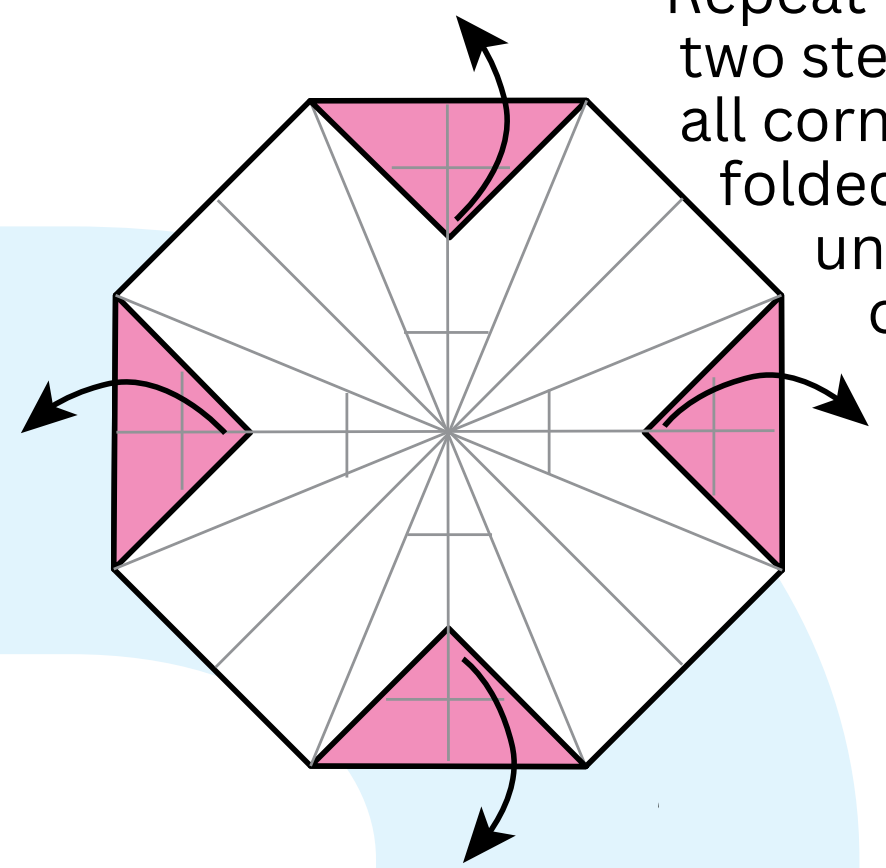
Fold half of the corners (the tips) upwards.



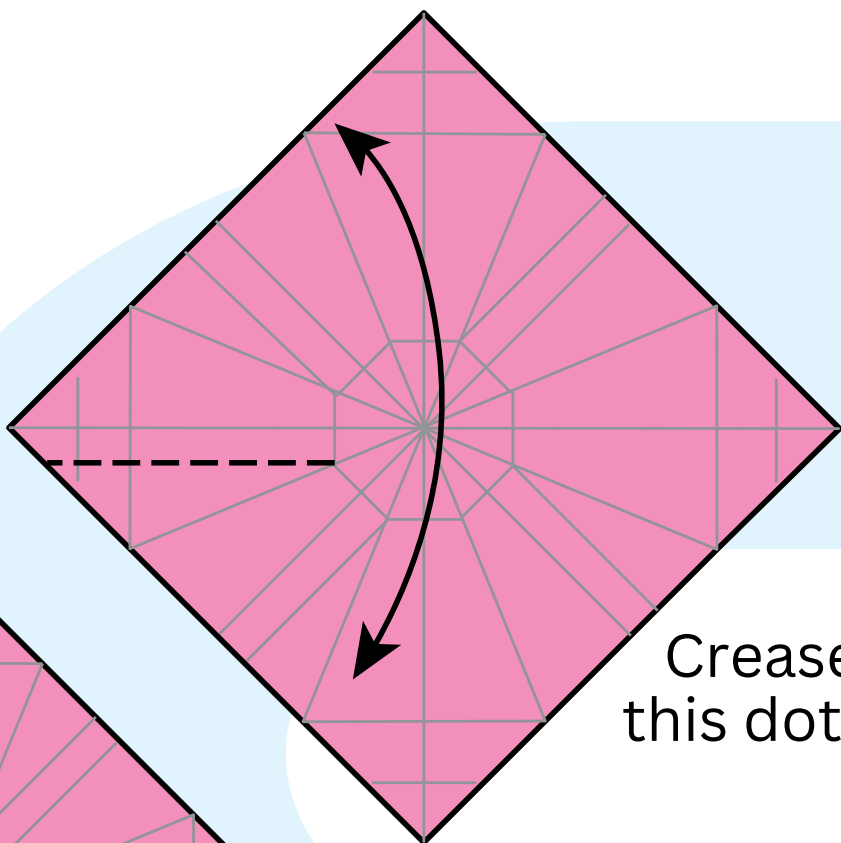
Fold the tip of this corner to the fold in this corner.



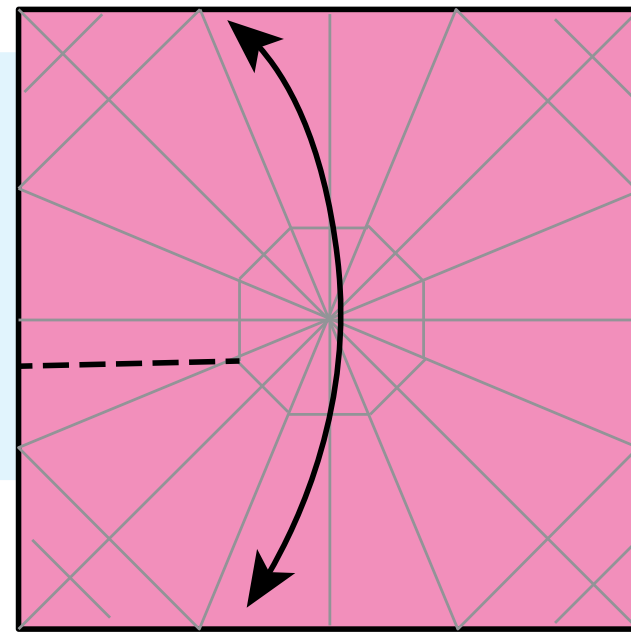
Repeat the past two steps until all corners are folded. Then unfold all corners.



Flip and repeat until all four sides are creased.

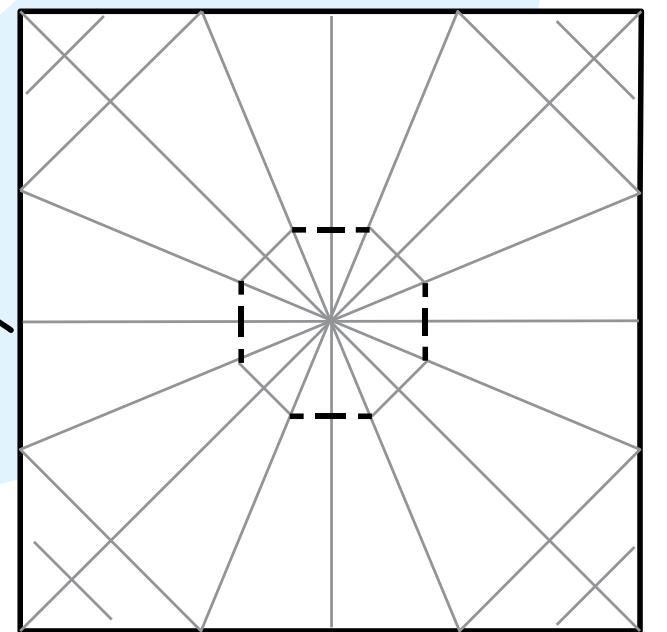
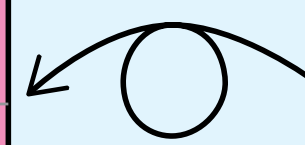


Rotate



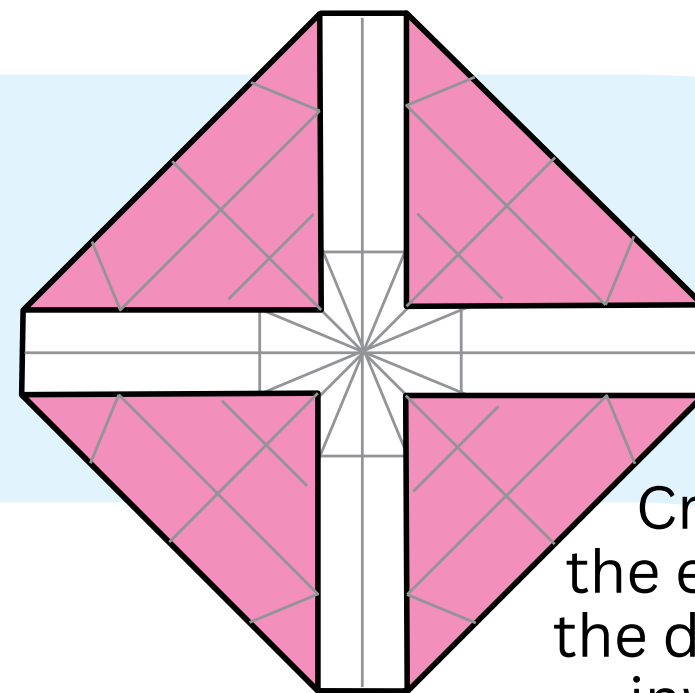
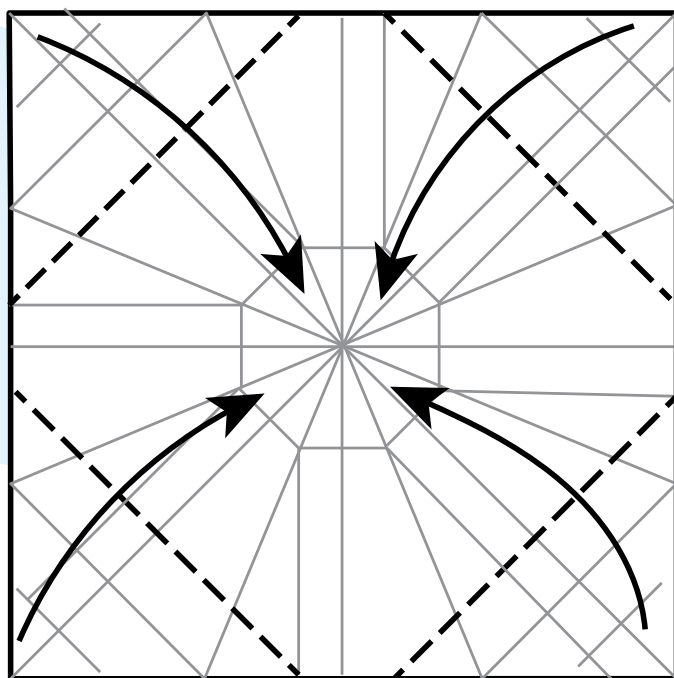
Crease along this dotted line.

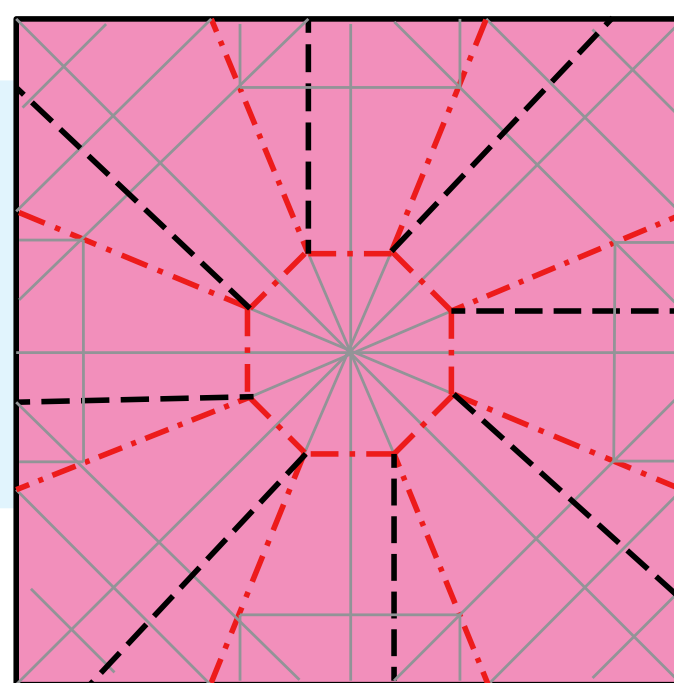
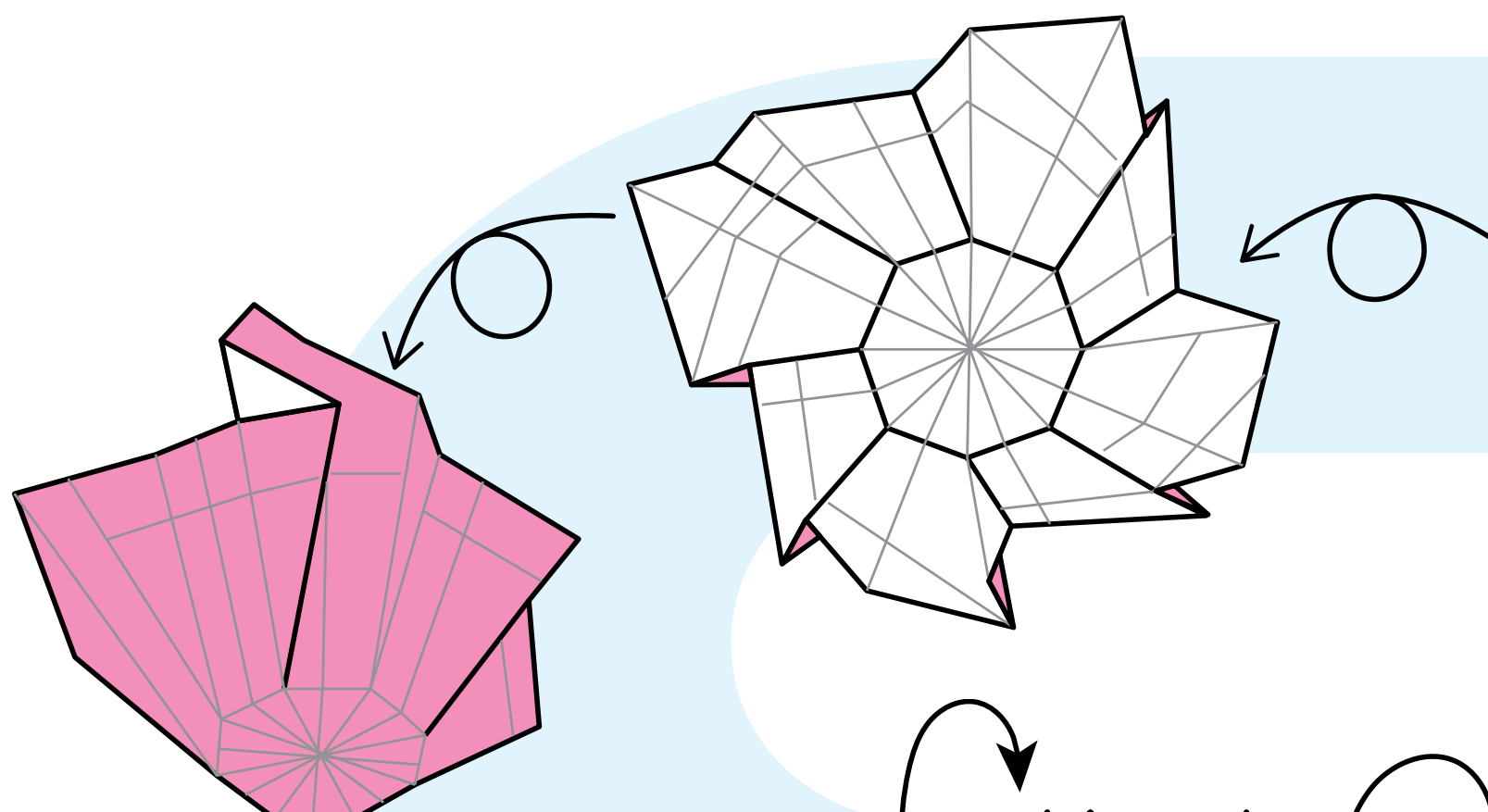
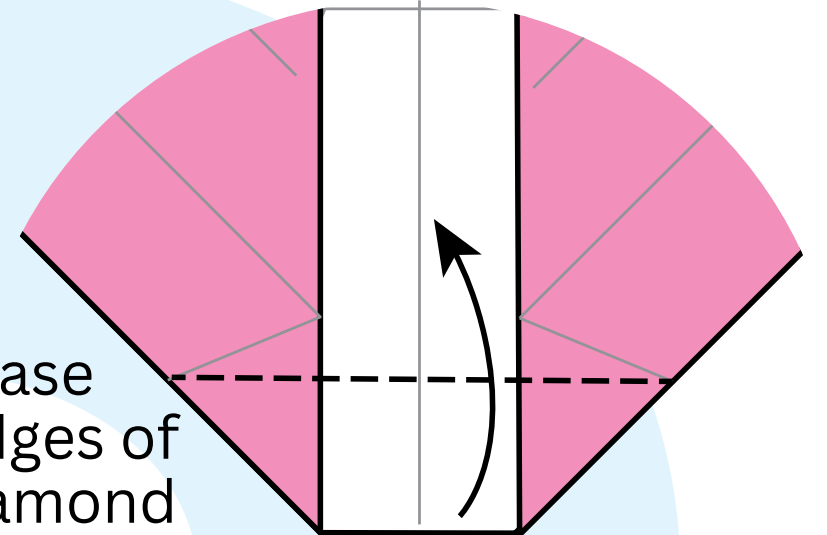


Complete the octagon shape, by creasing the center.

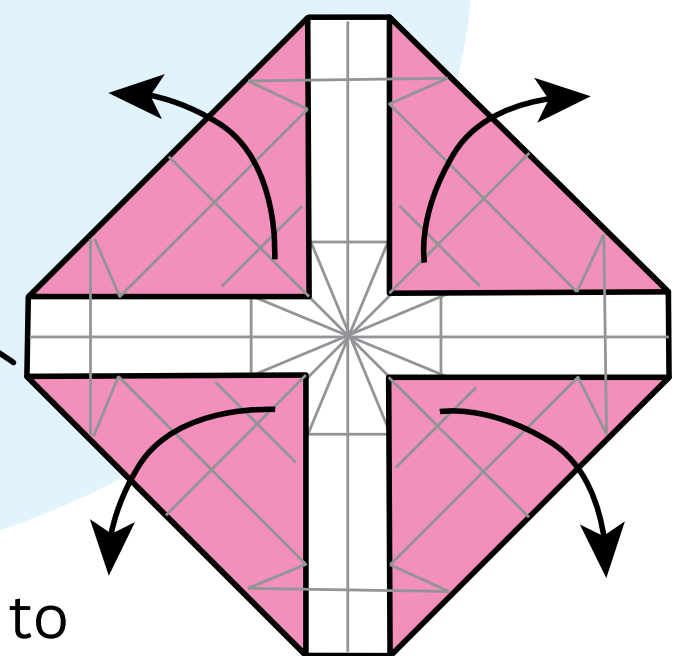
Flip over paper and fold the corners inward. Fold only until the paper forms a diamond, not a square.



Crease the edges of the diamond inward.

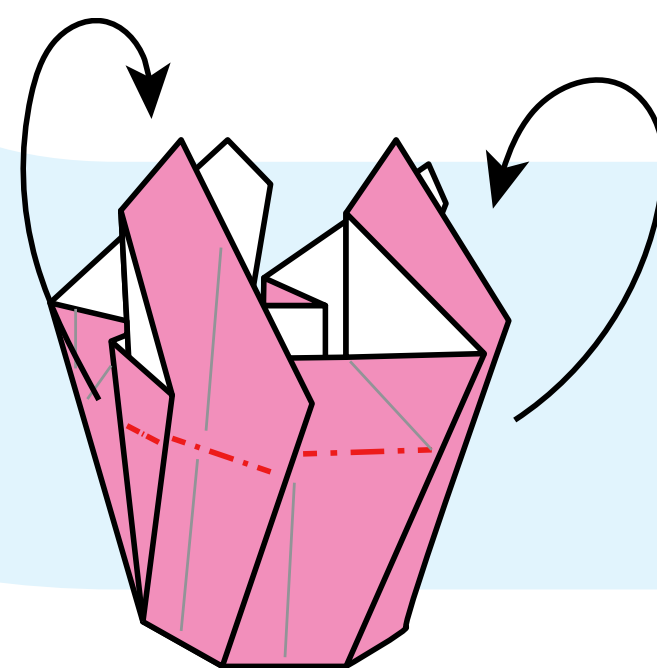


Start to crumple/fold the paper along these red/black lines.

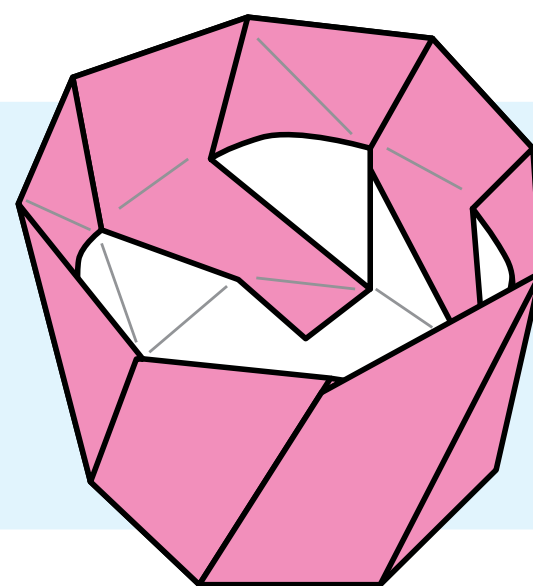


Unfold the paper.

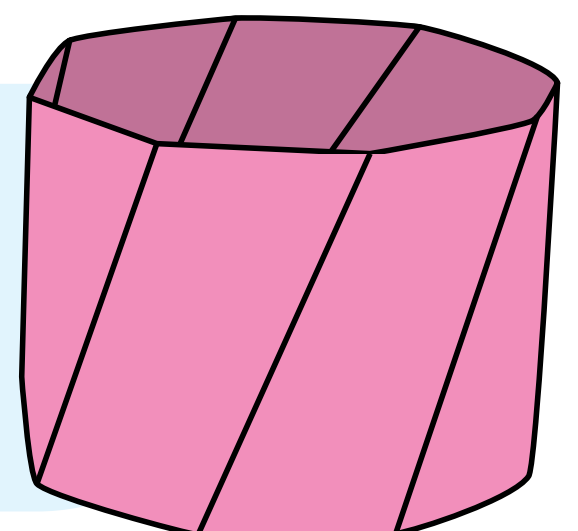
Hold the pot and fold the to sections (corners) inward. You can do this one section at a time or all together.



Continue folding, your paper should now start to form a pot.



Tape the folds in place if needed.



# Dirt:

For this step you will need:  
1 sheet of 15 x 15cm brown paper.

**\*You can substitute the pot by repeating this step with your unique colored paper!**
