

# JRML TWEEN TIME SNOWY PENGUIN



## Supplies needed:

- Paint brushes (4 sizes, see chart below)
- Acrylic paint (Black, white, orange, pink, red, and blue.)
- Canvas (Any size)
- Paper towel
- Cup of water
- Newspaper



### Helpful tip!

Consider putting down newspaper to avoid paint staining your table!

**Step 1 (Sky):** With your giant paint brush, paint your entire canvas blue.

**Step 2 (Snow):** Paint a little snow on the ground.

**Step 3 (Penguin):** With your large paintbrush, paint one giant black U - this will be your penguin's body. Then paint a smaller black U above the giant circle - this will be your penguin's head. Your penguin should look like a snowman or an 8. **Let the paint dry before moving onto the next step!**

**Step 4:** With the medium brush, fill in your U shapes with white paint.

**Step 5 (Penguin's feet):** On the left side of the large black circle, with the detail brush, Paint three orange triangles next to one another. Repeat on the other side of the circle.


## BRUSH SIZES

- 1: Large
- 2: Medium
- 3: Small
- 4: Detail



## PAINT BRUSH CARE:

Clean your paint brushes with warm water and wipe off on a paper towel. Clean your brush in-between each step.

**Step 6 (Penguin's face):** With the detail brush, paint an orange triangle in the middle of the penguin's head - this will . Then paint a black dot on the left triangle and one on the right side - this will be your penguin's eyes.

**Step 7 (Winter Accessories):** With a small brush, paint a red hat. With a detail brush, decorate with polka dots, stripes, hearts, and more! - see the tutorial below!

How to paint a hat:



Paint a long, slightly curved rectangle.



Paint a half circle on top of the rectangle.



Paint a small circle on top of the half circle.

**Step 8:** With a small brush, paint a red scarf. Decorate with stripes, hearts, polka dots, and more! - see the tutorial below!

How to paint a scarf:



Paint a long, slightly curved rectangle.




Paint two long rectangles hanging from the curved rectangle

**Step 9:** Optional - paint some blush onto your penguin.

**Step 10:** Paint some snow (dots of white paint) around your penguin to create snow.


