

Brush Sizes:

1 is large, 2 is medium, 3 is small, and 4 is a detail sized brush.



Paint Brush Care:

Clean your paint brushes with warm water and wipe off on a paper towel. Clean your brush in-between each step.



JRML Tween Time Out of This World Painting

Supplies needed:

- Paint brushes (4 sizes, see chart below)
- Acrylic paint (Black, white, red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple, and grey)
- Canvas (Any size, we used 4"x6")
- Paper towel
- Cup of water
- Newspaper





Instructions:


Step 1 (Space): With a large brush, paint your canvas black. Let it dry before moving onto step 2! (See picture 1)

Step 2 (White paint): With your small brush and white paint, paint: (See picture 2 for examples)

- 3 white planets (different sized circles)
- 2 Stars
- A sun (a half circle in the top right corner.)
- A comet (a circle with a triangle at one end.)
- A space ship (See tutorial below!)

Hint: Light colors do not show up well on a dark background. So, painting everything white first makes the colors pop!

Spaceship!



Step 3 (Spaceship): Paint your spaceship grey. (See picture 3)

Step 4 (Stars): Paint your stars yellow. Add a few white and yellow dots to create tiny stars! (See picture 4)
















Step 5 (Spaceship): Paint the top/window of the spaceship blue.

Step 6 (Sun): Paint the sun orange. (See pictures 6 & 8)

Step 7: While the orange paint is still wet, paint a red ring around the sun. Move your brush back and fourth to blend the colors together. (See pictures 6 & 8)

Step 8 (Planets): Paint your 3 planets a color - we used blue, red, and green.

Step 9: While your planets are still wet, paint a ring around the planet using a darker color. For example, we painted the planet blue and then painted a purple ring around it. While the paint is still wet, swirl your brush until the colors start to blend together. (See pictures 8-10)


Step 10 (Shooting star): Paint your comet orange and give it a yellow tail. Swirl the colors to really blend them together. **(See pictures 6-8)**

Step 11: Accessorize your spaceship! Paint small dots around the edge of the spaceship and/or lines! Have fun with it! (See picture 10)

Step 12: Paint an alien inside of the spaceship. (See picture 11 and/or tutorial below!)

Alien








Make an upside down U

for the body.



Make two circles for

eyes.



Make a heart, two bumps to make a peace sign.



Make eyes and a mouth!

Step 13 (Optional): we finished our painting with glitter spray paint.

Step 14: Yay! Now you're finished with your alien painting! Way to go!!! (See picture 11!)
