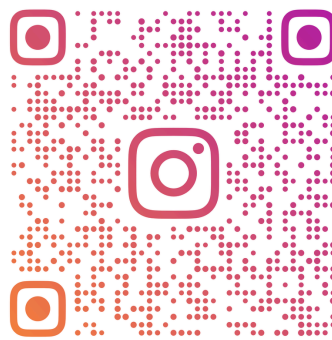

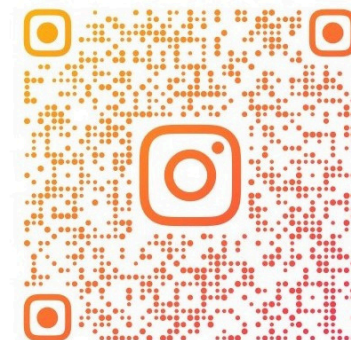

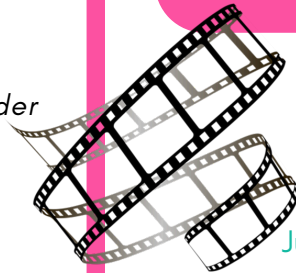
Unearth your love for science in this interactive S.T.E.M. show! Volunteers help conduct exciting experiments while we celebrate scientists who work with dirt!
